

Show Me Questions

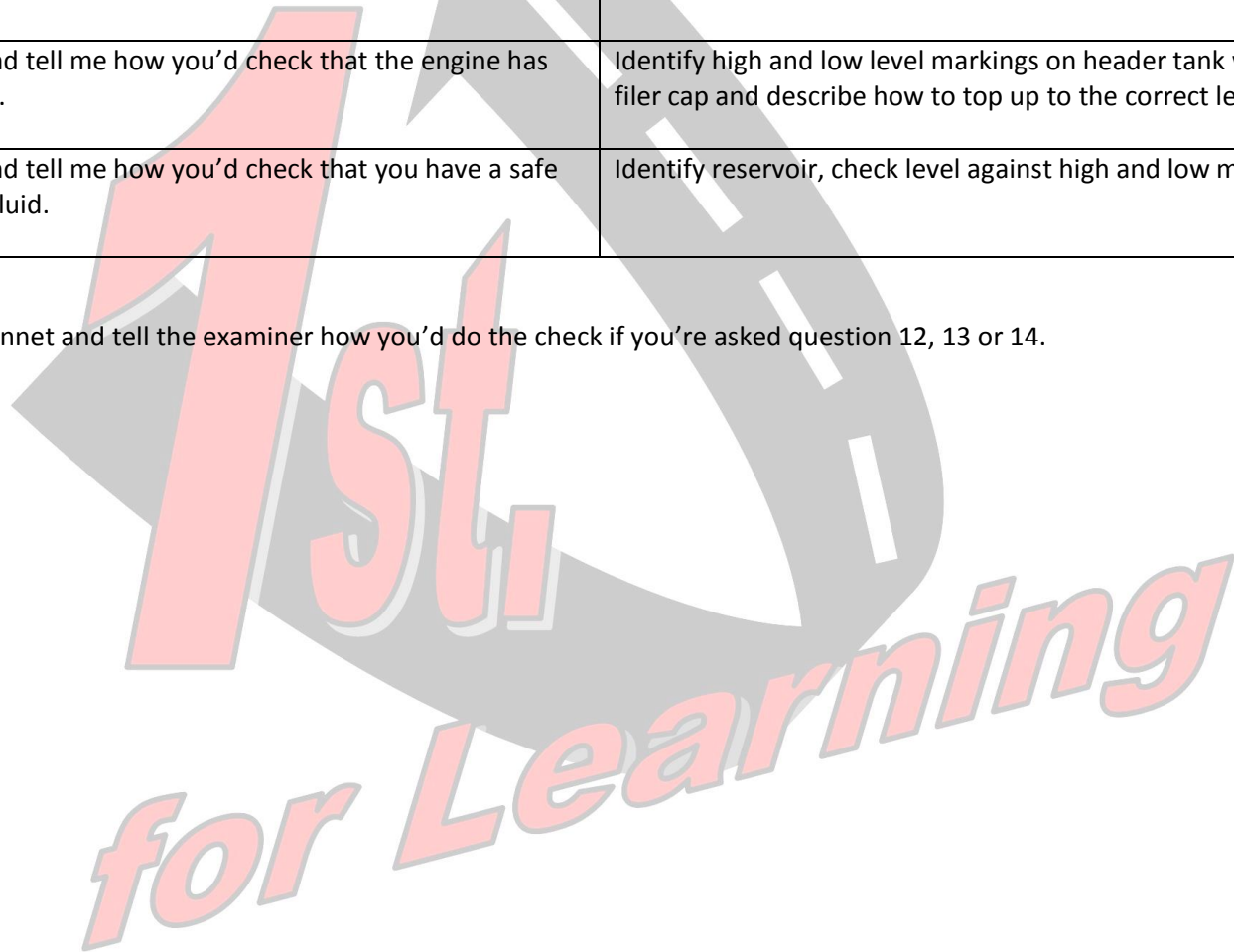
Question	Answer	
When it's safe to do so, can you show me how to wash the rear windscreen?		Pull the windscreen wiper stick towards the rear of the car until the rear washer water jet operates along with the with the rear wiper. Push the lever back to its original position to switch it off.
When it's safe to do so, can you show me how you wash and clean the front windscreen?		Depress the button on the end of the windscreen wiper stick until the washer operates along with the front wiper blades. The wipers will stop automatically.
When it's safe to do so, can you show me how you'd switch on the dipped headlights?		Rotate the headlight switch to the dipped headlight position shown.
When it's safe to do so. Can you show me how you'd set the rear demister?		Press the rear windscreen demister button
When it's safe to do so, can you show me how you'd operate the horn?		Press the horn in the centre of the steering wheel.
When it's safe to do so, can you show me how you'd demist the front windscreen?		Press the front windscreen demister button
When it's safe to do so, can you show me how you'd open and close your side window?		Press the window switch down to lower the window then up to raise the window

Tell Me Questions

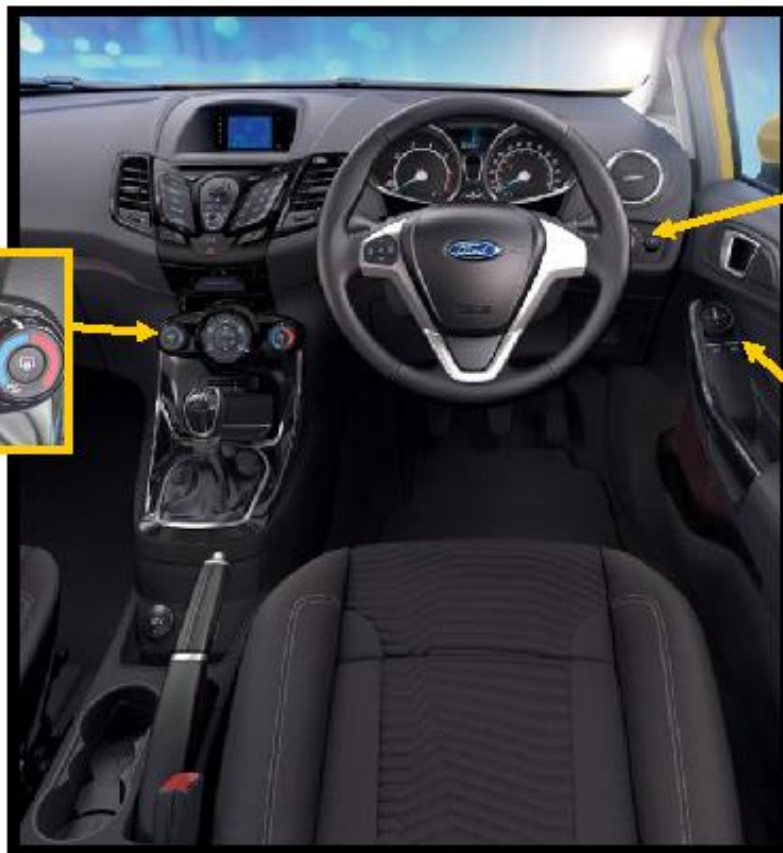
Question	Answer
1. Tell me how you'd check that the brakes are working before starting a journey.	Brakes should not feel spongy or slack. Brakes should be tested as you set off. Vehicle should not pull to one side.
2. Tell me where you'd find the information for the recommended tyre pressures for this car and how the tyre pressures should be checked.	In the Manufacturer's guide, use a reliable pressure gauge, check and adjust pressures when the tyres are cold, don't forget spare tyre, remember to refit the valve caps.
3. Tell me how you make sure your head restraint is correctly adjusted so it provides the best protection in the event of a crash	The head restraint should be adjusted so the rigid part of the head restraint is at least as high as the eye or top of your ears, and close to the back of the head as is comfortable.
4. Tell me how you'd check the tyres to ensure that they have sufficient tread depth and that their general condition is safe to use on the road.	No cuts or bulges, 1.6mm of tread depth across the central three-quarters of the breadth of the tyre and around the entire outer circumference of the tyre.
5. Tell me how you'd check that the headlights and tail lights are working. You don't need to exit the vehicle.	Explain how you'd operate the switch (turn on ignition if necessary), then walk around the vehicle. (as this is a 'tell me question you don't have to physically check the lights).
6. Tell me how you'd know if there was a problem with the anti-lock braking system.	The warning light should illuminate if there is a problem with the anti-lock braking system
7. Tell me how you'd check the direction indicators are working. You don't need to exit the vehicle.	Explain you'd operate the switch (turn on ignition if necessary), and then walk around the vehicle (as this is a 'tell me question you don't have to physically check the lights).
8. Tell me how you'd check the brake lights are working on this car	Explain you'd operate the brake pedal, making use of reflections in window, doors etc or ask someone to help.
9. Tell me how you'd check the power assisted steering is working before starting a journey.	If the steering becomes heavy, the system may not be working properly. Before starting a journey, 2 simple checks can be made. Gentle pressure on the steering wheel, maintained while the engine is started, should result in a slight but noticeable movement as the system begins to operate. Alternately turning the steering wheel just after moving off will give an immediate indication that the power assistance is functioning.
10. Tell me how you'd switch on the rear fog light(s) and explain when you'd use it/them. You don't need to exit the vehicle.	Operate the switch (turn on dipped headlights and ignition if necessary). Check warning light is on. Explain use.

Question	Answer
11. Tell me how you switch your headlights from dipped to main beam and explain how you'd know the main beam is on.	Operate switch (with ignition on if necessary), check with main beam warning light.
*12. Open the bonnet and tell me how you'd check that the engine has sufficient oil.	Identify dipstick/oil level indicator, describe check of oil against the minimum and maximum markers.
*13. Open the bonnet and tell me how you'd check that the engine has sufficient engine coolant.	Identify high and low level markings on header tank where fitted or radiator filler cap and describe how to top up to the correct level.
*14. Open the bonnet and tell me how you'd check that you have a safe level of hydraulic brake fluid.	Identify reservoir, check level against high and low markings.

*You need to open the bonnet and tell the examiner how you'd do the check if you're asked question 12, 13 or 14.

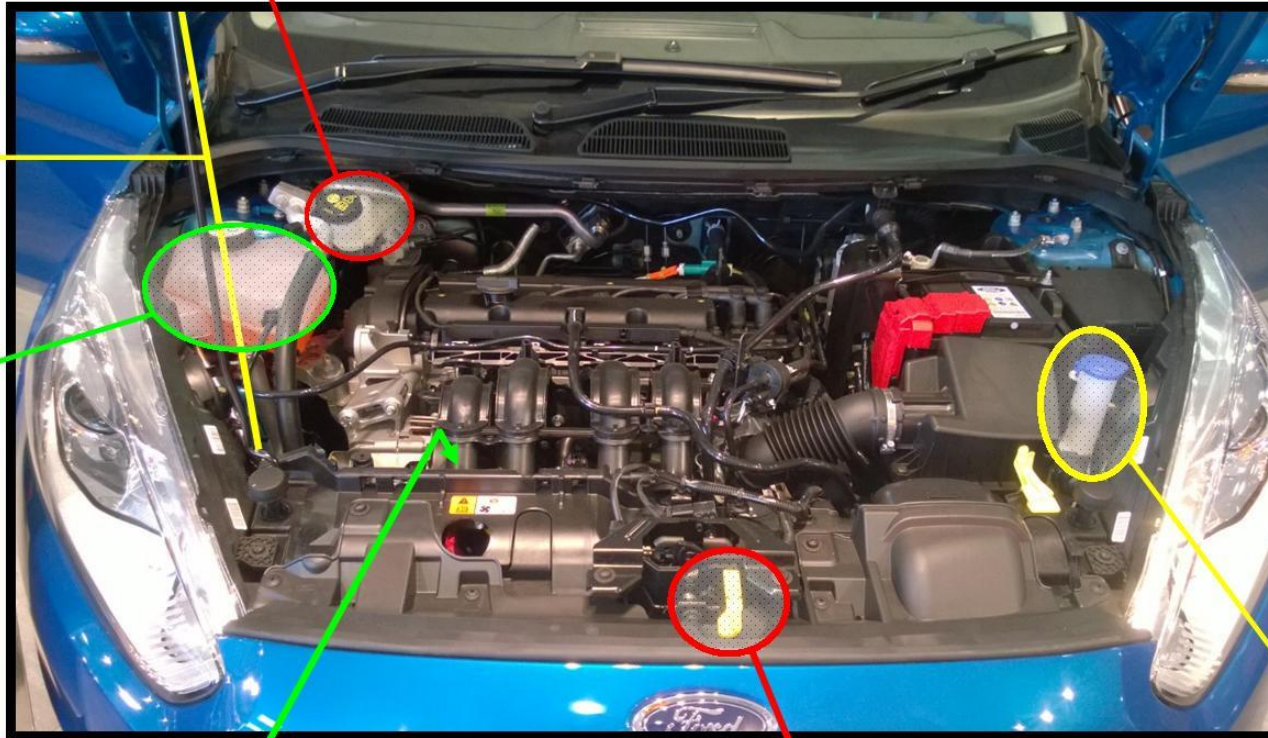

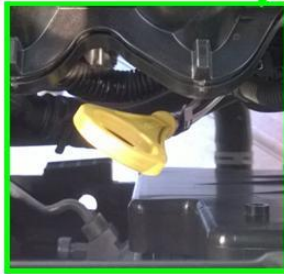
